

This map displays the number of overnight visits reported from 2007 - 2009 by patrons living in quarantined counties (not necessarily within the quarantine boundary) of the USA known to be infested with the following exotic pests:

- European Gypsy Moth (GM)
- Asian Longhorn Beetle (ALB)
- Emerald Ash Borer (EAB)
- Pine Shoot Beetle (PSB)
- Sirex Woodwasp (SWW)

This map displays most federal, state and private campgrounds & RV parks compiled by Idaho Dept. of Parks and Recreation. Pest risk data is only available for camp sites that were reserved using the National Recreation Reservation Service. State and private pest risk data is not included. Pest risk data was generated from federal quarantine reports.
