Update from USDA/FSA:

- Idaho will be flown again in 2011 – full state coverage, 1-meter, true color.
- There is another partnership opportunity to purchase the 4th band and deliverables for \$140,911.
- Partnership will provide access to color infrared band and all deliverables (CCMs and QQs). Without partnership, deliverables must be purchased, although it is expected that eventually (true color) CCMs would be available for download through NRCS Spatial Data Gateway.
- NAIP 2011 will be the last flight under the current program. In 2012 – everything changes, possibly to Imagery For the Nation.
- No CCMs after 2011 because FSA is moving to internal image and web services.
- There may be a ½ meter pilot project flown, but not sure which state will be selected for pilot.
- Parties interested in ½ meter resolution should begin coordinating the necessary secondary contract now (even though contractors have not been determined/selected for states yet). ADS40 cameras allow greater flexibility for flight path changes to accommodate higher resolution over the DMC cameras.
- All secondary contracts must be approved by APFO.
- Idaho will require 6554 QQs (two completely water QQs will now be included)
- Daily flight window will remain the same as last year (continuing contract).

Image Delivery Services Update:

- INSIDE Idaho provided [statistics](#) on first month of web mapping services.
- Image Service is the most popular, followed by natural color, then false color, then footprints.
- ISU did not load statistical software, but probably is very close to the trends seen at INSIDE.
